Anti-Bullying Week. As part of this week, time will be spent in classes talking about the different forms that bullying can take, how it can make people feel, and what we call all do to stop it.

Remote learning on SeeSaw. To clarify, there are homework activities on SeeSaw for the whole class once a week. Class teachers are also adding work on a daily basis for those children who are isolating, these pieces of work do not have to be completed by the whole class, just by those who cannot be here.

Keeping Warm. We work throughout the day with doors and windows open and it gets a bit fresh sometimes! Extra layers of clothes mean everyone stays comfortable and warm. Please could every child bring a warm coat for break and lunchtime play.

Keeping safe in lockdown 2. We continue to do everything we can in school to keep your children safe in line with government guidance. We have staff who care for or live with vulnerable adults. As cases rise can I ask you to:

Be punctual at drop off/pick up times with one adult dropping and collecting.

Keep your children with you until their allocated time so they are not mixing bubbles.

Leave as soon as you have dropped your children off or picked them up. If you are collecting two children, please find a space on site away from others, on the grass bank or a spot on the slope. The rules allow us to only meet in a public, outdoor space with ONE other person. Thank you for your understanding, we will all get through this together if we do the right thing.
