



## **Parent and Visitor Behaviour Policy**

At Brimscombe C of E VA Primary School we believe staff, parents and children are entitled to a safe and protective environment in which to learn and work. All members of the school community and visitors should demonstrate mutual respect. Any behaviour that may lead to feelings of harassment, alarm or distress to members of our community will not be tolerated and action will be taken.

### **Expectations:**

- That all adults (staff, governors, parents, carers and volunteers) set a good example to children at all times, showing them how to get along with all members of the school and the wider community.
- That no one - staff, governors, parents, carers, volunteers or children be subjected to abusive behaviour or any form of threats from anyone on the school premises.
- That physical attacks and threatening behaviour, abusive or insulting language verbal or written (including on social media), to staff, governors, parents, carers, volunteers, children and other users of the school premises will not be tolerated and may result in a ban from school premises and/or police action.

### **Adult Code of Conduct**

We have a Code of Conduct that relates to adults whilst on the school premises and/or representing the school at an approved off-site activity.

Brimscombe C of E VA Primary School expects the highest standards of behaviour from its pupils and that adults associated with the school, in any capacity, will set a good example.

Brimscombe C of E VA Primary School will not tolerate behaviour that compromises the safety and well-being of children and adults whether parents, members of staff, visitors or governors.
