

Dear Parents/Carers,

Homework will start the week beginning 11<sup>th</sup> September. I aim to give out the homework on a Friday and expect it back by the following Friday to be marked.

### PE and Outdoor Learning

PE Kits; please make sure children come to school in their PE kits every Tuesday. Suitable footwear is really important as we will be outside most PE sessions.

### What to wear and bring to school

All students should come to school in full school uniform. Students should pack a water bottle, hat and a packed lunch (if needed). Please make sure your child brings their reading book and reading record into school with them every day. Please make sure all personal items are labelled.

### Drop off and collection

Children should arrive between 8:45-8:55am to begin the school day at 9am. The school day finishes at 3:15 and pupils will need to be collected from the edge of the carpark and handed over to the designated adult responsible for them. Please let the school know if there are any changes to pick up arrangements.
