<p><b>Create a map</b></p> <p>Research your journey to school and all the different landmarks you pass each day. Draw a map depicting this journey. Use lots of colours and clear labels.</p>	<p><b>Shadow games</b></p> <p>Measure the shadow an object creates using a torch and plain piece of paper – you can record your results however you like. This piece of homework can be presented as a show and tell in class.</p>	<p><b>Classify objects</b></p> <p>Find 5 different materials around the house. Conduct an experiment to decide whether these materials are opaque, transparent or translucent.</p>
<p><b>Create a cover album</b></p> <p>What's your favourite song? Draw a cover for this song. Make sure you make it colourful and appealing to an audience.</p>	<p><b>Practise your 4 times tables.</b></p> <p>Create and answer multiplication and division questions for the 4 times tables.</p>	<p><b>Write a biography</b></p> <p>Choose a relative or friend and write a biography about their life so far. Include subheadings and interesting facts. You could use a computer to create your masterpiece.</p>
<p><b>Find the perimeter of 5 different objects in your house.</b></p> <p>Draw the objects and show your calculations.</p>	<p><b>Create a poster</b></p> <p>Use your knowledge of the harmful effects of the sun to create a poster advising other children to wear sun cream and hats during sunny days.</p>	<p><b>Create a piece of music</b></p> <p>Think of the song we use to remember our 4 times tables. Can you create a short piece of music to help other children remember something? This piece of homework can be presented as a show and tell in class.</p>
