We would like to welcome you and your child to Ladybirds Preschool at Brimscombe Church of England Primary School. Our 16 place preschool class is for children from 3 years old. For children under 3yrs and their families we have Bumble Bees, who meet in our school hall every Friday from 9.30 to 11.00am, it is a great way to meet local families.

Our professional Ladybirds staff include:

Pam Hose (Miss Hose)—Pre-school Assistant.

Our very experienced staff run the preschool provision full time Monday to Friday 8.45am until 3.00pm. Our wonderful setting provides an ideal foundation for your child in preparation for life at school, also enabling a seamless transition to Robins class (reception). Here at Ladybirds we seek to promote a safe and enjoyable learning environment through play, designed to encourage your child's natural curiosity, to promote confidence and strengthen their



learning for their next steps.

We have our own Facebook page alongside the school website, keeping you up to date with all our adventures. (Ladybirds pre school - Brimscombe primary) Seesaw is an online individual learning journal, where photos and short videos of them engaging in play will be posted regularly for you to view. We will provide you with an access code on your child's first day.

Children are all unique and learn in different ways, we encourage learning through play with adult interventions to extend knowledge and understanding.



It is important for us to know that parents/carers feel they can come and talk to us any time, Mrs B welcomes the children in every morning at the gate, and is happy to answer questions or listen to any concerns, and we are always very happy to set aside a time to meet with you for an informal chat if more time is needed.



Funding & Fees

Children can attend our Preschool using the 15 hours of universal Government funding, parents/carers will just need to complete a form every term given by us. We also accept applications from those who are eligible for 30 hours of childcare; the criteria for this is detailed on the .GOV website, if you are successful a code will be given to you for us to use. Once we receive this completed application form, you will be sent an email confirming a start date.

Children are entitled to attend full time 5 days a week starting at 8.45am. For those who come for the morning they can be collected at 12.00pm before lunch. Lunchtime is 12.15 to 1.00pm. Children who come for the afternoon can arrive at 12.00 ready for a fun afternoon!



Charges.

The sessions attended over the funded 15 hours are charged at £13.50 a session. This can be paid via an online portal called parentpay, you will be given an activation letter for this. An invoice will be sent for these hours.

Lunches.

Our preschool children who attend all day are welcome to either bring a healthy packed lunch (no nuts), or order a hot meal from our school caterer, The Great Plate, part of the long table group. This can also be paid for on parentpay at a cost of £2.41 a day.

Sun cream must be applied at home for the day or light clothes to cover exposed skin. Please name all belongings.
